POWERLIFTING: All special Olympic/disable lifters only: for all categories, women & men.

DAY 2 - Tuesday - June 2nd

RAW POWERLIFTING: for all categories, men.

DAY 3 - Wednesday - June 3rd

CLASSIC RAW POWERLIFTING: for all categories, women.

DAY 4 - Thursday - June 4th

CLASSIC RAW POWERLIFTING: for all categories men, teenage junior & masters.

DAY 5 - Friday June 5th

CLASSIC RAW POWERLIFTING: for all open men.

DAY 6 - Saturday June 6th

BENCHPRESS (RAW, SINGLE-PLY, MULTIPLY & UNLIMITED) for all categories, women & men.

DEADLIFT (RAW, SINGLE-PLY, MULTIPLY) for all categories, women & men.

● Weigh-in Schedule

Weigh-ins will take place at the venue the Castletroy Park Hotel.

ID passport or driver license must be shown at weigh-in under no circumstances will any lifter be permitted to weigh-in without official ID.

Under no circumstances will any lifter be allowed weigh-in on the day lift.

Day 1 – Lifters weigh in on Sunday May 31st. 10.00am–12.00pm & 3.00pm–5.00pm

All other days Weigh-in times are daily @ 9.00am–11.00am & 3.00pm–5.00pm

Day 2 – Lifters weigh-in on Monday 1st.

Day 3 – Lifters weigh-in on Tuesday 2nd.

Day 4 – Lifters weigh-in on Wednesday 3rd.

Day 5 – Lifters weigh-in on Thursday 4th.

Day 6 – Lifters weigh-in on Friday 5th.

Awards ceremony will take place at the end of each day's lifting session.

● Lifters entry fees

Entry fee €110.00 - If doing crossover or additional divisions first entry is **€110.00** and all other extra entries after are at **€55.00** per entry.

Lifters entering both Junior/Open or Master/Open same applies entry fee €110.00 + €55.00

ENTRY CLOSING DATE: Wednesday April 1st 2026

This is strictly the deadline there will be no late penalty fee option after this date there will be NO EXCEPIONS
